# MGA CADDIE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

## OUR MISSION

The MGA Caddie Scholarship Fund (MGACSF) fosters the core values of personal responsibility, integrity, and perseverance by giving young men and women in service to golf the opportunity to further enhance their lives through the pursuit of higher education. The Fund provides college scholarships to qualified candidates based on financial need.

## OUR HISTORY

The MGACSF was established in 1956 by renowned amateur golfer Willie P. Turnesa and his good friend Udo Reinach. With more than 3,170 recipients since its founding, the MGACSF has provided in excess of \$28,500,000 in scholarship funding.

## OUR SCHOLARSHIPS

The MGACSF is one of the largest organizations of its kind in the nation with awards that range from \$1,000 to \$15,000 per year for undergraduate study or study at an accredited trade school. Maximum awards are awarded to exceptional students with exceptional need.

## ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must demonstrate financial need, have applied to or currently attend an accredited school, and must have completed a minimum of two seasons in “service to golf” at participating clubs and courses in the Fairfield (CT), Bronx, Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Sullivan, Ulster and Westchester (NY) Counties. ‘Service to golf’ includes caddieing, working in the golf shop and bag room, on the practice range, and on the golf course superintendent’s crew. Please note that members or children of members of private golf and country clubs are not eligible to apply.

## FUNDING

The MGACSF finances scholarship awards primarily through contributions from individuals, local golf and country clubs, alumni, corporations, and foundations.

## NAMED AND ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS

Named and endowed scholarships give donors an opportunity to celebrate their commitment to education and golf. These special scholarships provide an enduring legacy for individuals, families, and organizations to pay tribute to an individual or organization.

Dear Friends, Members, Sponsors, and Supporters,

As President of the MGA Caddie Scholarship Fund, I am honored to provide an overview of our significant achievements in 2025.

With your steadfast support, we continue to make a positive

impact on the lives of young men and women from our communities as they pursue higher education. We awarded 213 scholarships in 2025-2026, totaling more than \$1,000,000 in essential financial assistance to these deserving scholars.

I am proud to report the continued growth of the MGACSF and the profound impact that scholarships have on local caddies and those who work in service to golf. For perspective, our longstanding Bag Tag program generated approximately \$6,000 in 1960; for 2025, contributions from this program reached \$975,000, funded exclusively by members of local golf clubs. Total contributions for the period ending June 30, 2025, are \$1.5 million, including revenue from key fundraising events such as the Annual Pro-Am, Friends of the Fund, and the Golf Marathon. (Additional details and recaps from these events can be found in this annual report, and we encourage you to participate in future events.)

Our future scholarship commitments now exceed \$4 million.

The scholars supported by the MGACSF exemplify more than commitment to caddieing—they embody the promise of future leadership within our communities. With educational costs continuing to rise, we respectfully ask for your continued generous support. The typical annual contribution to the Bag Tag program is equivalent to a caddie fee for a round of golf. If your club does not currently participate in the program, you may still contribute directly.

Our goals are to expand outreach to potential candidates, enhance program offerings for scholars, and increase our positive influence while upholding transparency and responsible management. Your ongoing partnership is crucial in supporting the next generation and preserving the values and traditions we all hold dear.

Thank you for your loyal support and for playing an integral role in our shared mission.

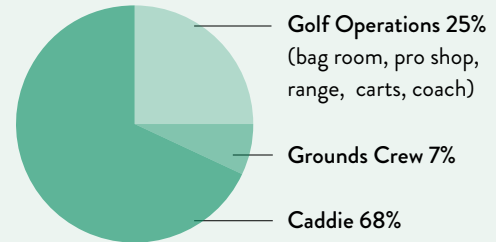

Dickinson College and at the 2025 American Association for Cancer Research Annual Meeting in Chicago.

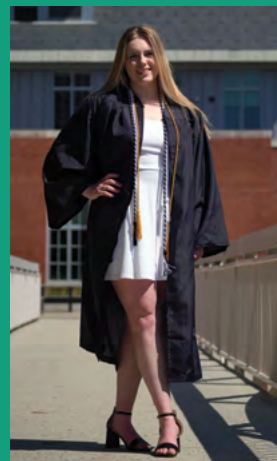

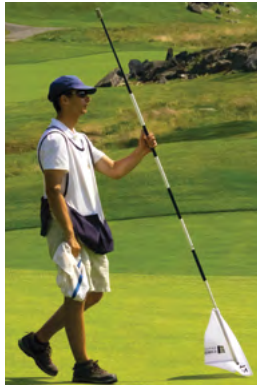
Participants competed in both gross and net Stableford competitions, with Daniel Meduri capturing the net title and Tim Nevin earning top honors in the gross division.
